## **NOTIFICATION**

Dhaka, the 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1990

**S.R.O.No.330-L/90/1334/Cus.**—In exercise of the Powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to direct that the goods specified in column (2) of the Table below and falling under the Heading Numbers of the First Schedule to the said Act specified in column (1) of the Table, which are the produce or manufacture of the countries signatory to the General System of Trade Preference Agreement dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 1988 indicated in column (3) of the Table, and have fulfilled the condition laid down in the Rules of Origin of the said Agreement shall be exempt from so much of the customs-duties leviable thereon as is in excess, of the rates of duty specified in column (4) of the Table:
